## ATC participates in eHealth Forum 2017

Similarly, <a href="City4Age">City4Age</a> is exploring the effective use of "intelligent" and IoT technologies to ensure a healthy ageing and independent living for older people. In addition, <a href="BD2Decide">BD2Decide</a> focuses on developing new prognostic models for the appropriate treatment of head and neck cancer cases, while <a href="EVOTION">EVOTION</a> aims to support decision making and shaping of holistic public health policies for hearing impaired people.
